Applications are invited for papers at the Anglicare Australia National Conference, to be held at the Hotel Grand Chancellor in Hobart on 20-23 September.

Workshops and presentations are an important part of the conference, giving participants an opportunity to exchange information, showcase successes, promote your organisation's agenda and make useful connections.

With a focus on the theme *Belonging*, we welcome workshops and presentations in all service types from member organisations.

Abstract Requirements

Please complete the abstract submission form, which covers:

- » Title of the paper
- » Names and affiliations of presenters
- » Style presentation or workshop
- » Length of time required (30, 45 or 90 min)
- » The thematic streams you plan to address
- » Abstract

Workshop sessions will be 90 minutes each. Each session will contain two presentations/workshops of 45 minutes each. However, proposals of 30 and 90 minutes will be considered.

Abstracts should include

- » 300 words maximum (text only)
- » The names of presenting author first
- » The names and organisations of other authors
- » Enough information to allow fair assessment
- » A description of the background, who should attend, the structure of workshop or presentation, and the intended outcomes.

Presentations and workshops may:

- » Cover a case study or innovative research topic
- » Outline current thinking or policy relevant to emerging need and practice
- » Showcase best practice methods or models of service.

You may wish to highlight points of difference in:

- » Remote vs metropolitan settings
- » Conceptual vs applied approaches
- » Competitive marketing vs community development
